NOTIFICATION

Subject : Central Sector Scheme on "ASSISTANCE FOR BOOSTING SEED PRODUCTION IN PRIVATE SECTOR " - regarding

Govt. of India, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare has clarified on the following points which were not clearly spelt in the guidelines "ASSISTANCE FOR BOOSTING SEED PRODUCTION IN PRIVATE SECTOR", vide letter No. 6-17/2015-SD-1 dated 18.03.2016 , which are as under :

C.	Transfer of Term loan account from one Bank to another Bank.	Permitted.
D.	How many times, one beneficiary can avail the benefits of this Scheme for same location or another location.	A beneficiary can avail benefits of this scheme on eligible capital project cost upto Rs. 150.00 lakhs either at a time or more than one time for creation of infrastructure for any number of location /place.
E.	Subsidy on DG Set.	Subsidy on cost of DG Set shall be allowed as under : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 1 to 2 TPH capacity : 45 - 55 KVA. 2. 2 to 3 TPH capacity : 65 - 75 KVA. 3. 4 to 5 TPH capacity : 75 - 100 KVA.
F.	Subsidy on transportation, freight, erection, commissioning and electrification charges.	Upto 2.5% of total cost of eligible machineries for seed processing plant.



G.	Capital investment of project for the purpose of release of subsidy shall be calculated as follows : 1. For seed godown with AC/GI sheet. 2. For storage godown with flat roof. 3. Seed Processing Plant structure	Revised rates are as under : 1. Rs. 7000/- per sq.mt. 2. Rs. 7500/- per sq.mt. or actual cost whichever is lower. 3. Rs. 7000/- per sq.mt. or actual cost whichever is lower.
9.	Methodology for allocation of funds for SC/ST and women applicant.	As per prevailing rule of Govt. of India.
10.	List of Hilly and Scheduled areas where 50% subsidy on eligible capital cost will be given.	Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Hill areas of Uttrakhand, Hill areas of West Bengal, Hill areas of Nilgiris, Kodaikanal, Yercaud. All North Eastern States including Sikkim.

The upper limit of the project cost would be capped at Rs. 150.00 lakhs per beneficiary (either at a time or more than one time) with maximum subsidy @ 40% amounting to Rs. 60.00 lakhs for general areas and @ 50% amounting to Rs. 75.00 lakhs in hilly and scheduled areas for any number of places.

The above shall be applicable only on all fresh proposals received after 01.05.2016.
